

**MINUTES  
INAUGURATION SPECIAL MEETING

**1. OATH OF OFFICE**

City Clerk, Judy Gaouette, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. and administered the Oath of Office. All Councilors present.

**2. ELECTION OF MAYOR PRO TEM**

The City Clerk then opened the floor to nominations for Mayor Pro Tem:

Whitmore moved to nominate Councilor Tom Dunnington, seconded by Tweedie.

Hindle moved to nominate Councilor Kathleen Taylor, seconded by Quigley.

Tweedie moved to vote by paper ballot, seconded by Whitmore.

Mayor Nossiff questioned the legality of a secret ballot at a public meeting and felt that without benefit of a legal opinion from the City Attorney, he would not be in favor.

Motion to vote by paper ballot failed on a 3-6 vote, Whitmore, Dunnington and Tweedie in favor.

Motion to elect Councilor Dunnington as Mayor Pro Tem failed on a 3-6 vote, Whitmore, Dunnington and Tweedie in favor.

Motion to elect Councilor Taylor as Mayor Pro Tem passed on 6-3 vote, Whitmore, Dunnington and Tweedie opposed.

Quigley moved to cast a unanimous vote in favor of Councilor Taylor for Mayor Pro Tem, seconded by Nossiff. Motion passed unanimously.

Quigley moved to adjourn, seconded and passed unanimously.
