ITEM NO. 1: ROLL CALL:

On Roll Call the following were present:  
Chairman R. Normand Alie, Vice-Chairman Raymond A. Bourque,  
Mrs. Lois Schofield, Mr. Wallace Akerman, Mr. John Sowerby,

Also attending were Mr. Ernest Hatch, Building  
Inspector and Mr. Louis Stocklan.

ITEM NO. 2: NEW BOND FOR BELLAMY DEVELOPMENT (Mr. Louis  
Stocklan):

Mr. Sowerby stated that final approval had  
been granted in 1968 to Mr. Stocklan for Bellamy Development  
with the stipulation that a bond be filed. A bond was  
never filed and prices for bonds had now been increased.  
Therefore the purpose of this meeting was to set a new  
bond for the subdivision.

Mr. Stocklan stated that Iafolla construction  
Company has agreed to set up the first part of the bond  
(\$12,650) and he would secure the second half (\$15,250).

Moved by Akerman, seconded by Bourque, to  
accept Iafolla's bond to cover the first half of \$12,650  
and Mr. Stocklan's security for the second half in the  
amount of \$15,250, a total figure of \$27,900 and that  
final approval be granted when these bonds are filed  
with the City Clerk. The Board further moved that this  
subdivision meet all City subdivision regulations as of  
July 1, 1971. Unanimously adopted.

ITEM NO. 3: OLD BUSINESS:

The Board then decided to make a site  
inspection of the Sweeney Tract on Wednesday, July 7, 1971  
at 8:00 a.m. at the site on Henry Law Avenue.

Moved by Alie, seconded by Mrs. Schofield,  
to adjourn. Unanimously adopted.
