ITEM NO. 1: ROLL CALL:

On Roll Call the following were present: Chairman Frank O. Estes, Mrs. Lois M. Schofield, Mr. Donald E. Chick, Mr. R. Normand Alie, Mrs. Joan Miller, Mr. Wallace I. Akerman, Mrs. Beverly Forest, Mr. Paul E. Hale.

Also attending was Planning Director Sheridan and City Engineer David B. Rundle and Michael Kúlka of the Strafford Regional Planning Commission.

ITEM NO. 2: APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON MARCH 12 and March 26, 1974:

Moved by Griffin, seconded by Mrs. Schofield, to approve as written. Unanimously adopted.

ITEM NO. 3: NEW BUSINESS:

- a. Resolution re: Dover Membership in Strafford Rockingham Regional Council:

After an extended discussion, it was decided to further research this issue.

- b. Proposed Revisions to Chapter 20 (Sidewalks & Sewers):

Mr. Rundle, City Engineer, explained the revisions to Chapter 20. The Planning Board felt the ordinance should be revised to make the Police Dept. the law enforcement officers. Mr. Rundle agreed to revise the ordinance as requested.

Moved by Griffin, seconded by Akerman, to accept as revised and that Councilwoman Miller take it to the City Council. Unanimously adopted.

ITEM NO. 4: OLD BUSINESS:

- a. Extension of Bond for Oxford Heights Project:

Mr. Sheridan read a communication from owner, Mr. Fred Shaw, asking for an extension for posting their performance bond.

Moved by Chick, seconded by Akerman, to grant a three month extension to Oxford Heights subdivision, said extension to expire on July 1, 1974. Unanimously adopted.

b. Discussion re: Proposed Modifications to PURD:

MR. Sheridan asked the Board in a vote with reference to continuing discussions on the Ordinance. Mrs. Schofield and Mr. Estes were opposed and all others were in agreement.
