ITEM NO. 1: ROLL CALL:

On Roll Call the following were present: Mr. Armand J. Dimambro, Mr. Raymond A. Bourque, Mr. Frank O. Estes, Mr. John H. Sowerby, Mr. Donald E. Chick.

Also attending were Miss Mary Louise Hancock, State Planning Director and Mr. Michael Blake of DRED in Concord.

Mr. Armand Dimambro was appointed Chairman. Mr. Chick was appointed Secretary Pro-Tem.

ITEM NO. 2: MEETING WITH MISS HANCOCK ON "701" PROGRAM:

Miss Hancock started the meeting by explaining that funds for "701" are very limited. However, if the Board desires, Miss Hancock will write a contract with Metcalf & Eddy, Inc.

She continued that a housing study would be necessary and it would be made by the University of New Hampshire and the State will contract with the University.

She continued that the planning standards part would be done by some consultant chosen by the State. The subdivision part will be contracted for by the State with a consultant. Zoning will be done within one year or the State will not get their next year's allotment.

Miss Hancock stated that she will get a contract for zoning with Metcalf & Eddy by the end of June for all planning proposed except housing, planning standards and subdivisions.

The State will bill the City for \$16,000 when payment is required.

The Meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
