Following the public hearings on Mr. McMahon's subdivision of Lots 9-48 and 9-49 and Mr. Tamposi's subdivision of Lots 4, 5 and 5A of Garrison Industrial Park, the Board held a regular meeting at which time the following motions and decisions were made.

MR. MCMAHON'S SUBDIVISION:

Moved by Dimambro, seconded by Akerman, to refer the Subdivision to the City Attorney to see if it meets all requirements. Unanimously adopted.

GARRISON INDUSTRIAL PARK, Lots 4, 5 and 5A:

Moved by Dimambro, seconded by Estes, to accept Lots 5 and 5A as one lot and Lot 4 as one lot. All future water and sewer costs to be at the owner's expense. Unanimously adopted. The Board agreed to notify the Building Inspector.

The Board also agreed that the City Attorney, Mr. McManus, should be notified and requested to attend the next meeting of the Planning Board to discuss Mr. McMahon's subdivision.

In other business, a letter recommending the release of the Bond on Prospect Street and Prospect Court be accepted and that the City Clerk be so notified.

It was agreed that the City Attorney be requested to be present at the next meeting of the Board to talk over with the Board the McMahon Subdivision.

Moved by Dimambro, seconded by Akerman, to adjourn. Unanimously adopted.
