MINUTES OF MEETING

ITEM NO. 1: ROLL CALL:

On Roll Call the following were present:
Chairman Akerman, Secretary Dimambro, Messrs. Alie, Chick,
Ouellette. Also attending were Carl Vancelette of WTSN,
and Jon Breen of Foster's.

Chairman Akerman stated that a bill had been
presented to the Board by Mr. Chandler in the amount of \$61.00
for consultant services at the previous meeting.

It was noted that the Council was not pleased with
Mr. Chandler's position with respect to the townhouse
controversy. This was discussed at length.

Mr. Chick finally agreed to write to Mr. Chandler
informing him that his services were no longer required by the
City and that he no longer represents the City in any capacity.
He agreed to tell Mr. Chandler to come to the Office, procure
any personal belongings that may be there and leave his key with
Mr. Chick.

Moved by Alie, seconded by Dimambro, to pay Mr.
Chandler the \$61 requested for the previous meeting.
Unanimously adopted.

ITEM NO. 2: TOWNHOUSE LOCATIONS:

The Board then discussed at length several locations
for townhouses in Dover. The Board discussed the areas of
Sixth Street, Glenwood Avenue, Whittier Street, beyond Old
Rochester Road and the Turnpike and the areas on the Dover
Point Road.

The Board agreed to meet again on Tuesday, July 1,
1969, at 6:30 in the evening to discuss townhouses further.
The Board then went on site inspection of the various proposed
areas.
