MINUTES OF MEETING
SPECIAL

The Special Meeting of the Dover Planning Board was called to order at 4:45 p.m. on Monday, May 15, 1967 in the Police Courtroom at City Hall.

On roll call, the following members were present: Chairman Robert T. Sheldon, Vice-Chairman Raymond R. Ouellette, Secretary Wallace I. Akerman, Albert O. Bernard, Arthur J. DuBois, Charles E. Prescott, Hugh C. Tuttle. Also in attendance were Planning Director William R. Chandler and Economic Director Clarence E. Chase.

ITEM NO. 1: ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATION FOR SUBDIVISION OF LAND FROM MESSRS. TAMPOSI, NASH AND LEHOULLIER:

Moved by DuBois, seconded by Bernard, to waive the Subdivision Regulations, accept the application of Messrs. Tamposi, Nash and LeHoullier and that a public hearing on same be held on Monday, May 22, 1966 at 7:30 p.m. in the Police Courtroom. At the request of the Board, the Economic Director spoke on the reasons for the request on waiving the regulations. Motion adopted unanimously.
