

DOVER PLANNING BOARD  
MINUTES OF MEETING  
PUBLIC HEARING

The Special Planning Board Meeting was called to order by Chairman Sheldon at 7:35 p.m. in the Police Courtroom on Monday, May 22, 1967.

On roll call, the following members were present: Chairman Robert T. Sheldon, Vice-Chairman Raymond R. Ouellette, Secretary Wallace I. Akerman, Albert O. Bernard, Donald E. Chick, Charles E. Prescott, Hugh C. Tuttle. Also attending were William R. Chandler, Planning Director, Clarence E. Chase, Economic Director, Grant L. Davis, Edward LeHoullier, Mrs. Eleanor Woodbury of WWNH and Mr. Jon Breen of WTSN and approximately twelve members of the public.

Mr. Sheldon explained that before any subdivision of land is acted upon, there must be a public hearing held and the applicant notified. He stated that this had been carried through and that all adjacent property owners were notified by letter.

The Planning Director briefly explained the Subdivision Plan from the map displayed and introduced Mr. LeHoullier, representing the developers Nash, Tamposi and LeHoullier. Mr. LeHoullier explained that they had purchased this property with the intent of industrial development.

Several members in the audience asked questions regarding the location of proposed water and sewer lines and the status of the Hanson Road. Their questions were answered by Members of the Board. No-one spoke in opposition to the proposal.
