Re: School Board Report

The Dover School Board met Monday, September 13, 2010.

Citizens Forum: Horne Street School mothers and PTA officers spoke in favor of hiring another 2nd grade teacher at Horne Street to reduce class size which has risen to 25/26 students per class.

Minutes: Approved

Consent Agenda: Board members pulled a couple of items. There was a questions concerning salaries for advisors of extra-curricular activities. Also questioned was the educational value of a student trip scheduled to go to Hawaii. The DHS academic dean explained what students were be involved in and the board agreed it would be a highly educational experience.

Moving items on the agenda, the board discussed the availability of funds to hire another teacher at Horne Street. It was determined that enrollment figures in second grade were resulting in class sizes of 25/26 students. Due to the reassignment of a teacher, there are funds in the budget available for this hire. The board approved this expenditure of funds.

Principal Patrick Boodey was called to the podium and questioned about enrollment in grade 2 at Woodman Park. The board approved hiring another teacher to lower class sizes at Woodman Park also.

Superintendent's Report: Superintendent Jean Briggs-Badger introduced the new Director of Curriculum to the board. She reported a smooth school opening. ESOL students passed their standardized tests with flying colors. A new medical program (in pharmacy) is going to be offered at the CTC which will be open to the public. The DHS Homecoming Day will be held on Oct. 2nd with plans for a packed agenda of activities. NECAP tests are coming up. An anti-bullying program is being planned.

Student Representative: Spirit week is being planned. The first football game was played. Student Council is up and running. Clubs have begun to meet. The switch in computer programs has caused some difficulty for students getting on line to see grades. A new cell phone policy has been instituted (none in class but allowed at lunch and in hallways) that students favor. New Teacher Induction Program: reported on by Sue Vitko. This is the 3rd year for this successful program which will be expanded into the high school. It provides a system of support for new staff and follows their progress while they are becoming experienced teachers.

ROT: The commander of our DHS JROTC program requested permission to establish a marksmanship program. It would require approval of 9 air rifles (to be kept under lock and key), a range, and a training program (emphasis on safety) for cadets. This would be an afterschool program and train cadets to compete with other schools. The U.S. Navy has donated all of the equipment necessary. The board approved this.

Committee Reports: The Media Access Center being constructed at the McConnell Center is ready to put out bids and have picked colors for the walls. They have \$121,746.20 still available. At Horne Street the gym floor is going in, the parking lot pavement is complete and lights are being installed. There was some interference to kindergarten students who needed to go outside the building to get to the cafeteria and this will be resolved before the bad weather. There was also a need to extend the kindergarten lunch hour. This JBC is considering solar panels. Their current balance is \$482,481.

Financial Report: After routine payment of bills, Business Administrator, Laurie Verville, gave a financial report to the board. One area of concern had been the cafeteria which did end up the fiscal year in the black.

Meeting was adjourned.

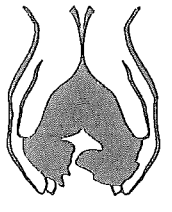
