#### **4. Report by Task Groups**

**A. Monitoring:** Bird received a copy of the 2008 monitoring list from Dave Price, but Price couldn't find the 2009 list. The Browne easement has been monitored.

**B. Outreach and Education:** We needed more OLC and trail maps which were reprinted for the opening of the Community Trail Opening. We still need to revise the OLC brochure; Anne Kotlus has offered to update it but hasn't gotten to it yet.

**C. Grant Writing:** None

**D. Trails:** Gasses reported that the Grand Opening of the urban portion of the Community Trail held on Saturday, November 13 was well attended. Over 150 people were there. Scott Meyers and others were present.

On Sunday, November 14, Trout Unlimited hosted a "How to Fly Fish" workshop for the Dover High School students.

#### **5. New Business:**

Gasses reported that the Planning Board approved a conservation subdivision for the Cochecho Country Club of about 14 acres. It will be purchased by The Nature Conservancy.

#### **6. Non-Public Meeting**

Bird made a motion to enter into non-public session for report on the status of individual land protection efforts/transactions per RSA 91-A:3. Lehocky seconded the motion and a roll call vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
