1. Call to Order by chair Rick Callaghan

3. Native and Exotic Plant Presentation by NH DES – presentation given by Amy Smagula NH DES and gave the attendees a chance to answer questions. Information presented included milfoil treatment to begin on June 15th and cover approximately 2 acres with a follow-up post-treatment in 30-45 days. Information was presented for “Weed Watchers” to identify milfoil and notify DES for its’ immediate removal. The committee and DES is seeking volunteers for the Weed Watchers which would involve going on the pond once a month during the summer.

Dean informed us about the resolution going forward to the Council on April 27, 2011 for a vote. Also discussed was the debate about the water level for the pond which will be an ongoing discussion in future AdHoc meetings.
