Re: School Board Report #1

The Dover School Board met in Special Session March 21st. The purpose was to announce that since both candidates interviewed by the board during the Superintendent Search were not chosen there would need to be an extension of the search process.

It was agreed that the position would be posted again for 10 days and then closed on Friday, April 4th. The current search committee would continue the process (I had to resign due to scheduling difficulties) using the results of community surveys. It was also noted that including a salary range in the advertisement might encourage more applicants (\$115,000 to \$140,000) to apply.

The Board also directed the Search Committee to narrow the time and effort expended by the community making the process easier.
