Mr. Lariviere expressed concern over the Commission taking on an appeal to a finding on the Ethics Commission itself?

Also, Mr. Clay acknowledges that the potential violations are not present in Chapter 22, but he appears to want the Ethics Commission to find some for him.

Mr. Licata expressed concerned about basic qualification of screening process

Dana acknowledged the “lack of standing” issue, but expressed concern about factual basis for a hearing.

Mr. Stolzenberg expressed he was struggling with standing issue as well.

Ms. Forcillo felt that the complaints were circular - original complaint is still the basis of dissatisfaction.

Mr. Nedelka also felt standing was clearest issue presenting a barrier to even screening the complaint, which also held issues but which would be rendered moot if Commission felt complaint didn't qualify to be screened.

Mr. Stolzenberg moved to dismiss complain on basis of 22-13A, residency requirement, 2nd by Ms. Forcillo.

Approved unanimously.

Mr. Nedelka moved to go to public meeting, Mr. Stolzenberg seconded, approved unanimously.
