DOVER SCHOOL BOARD – MINUTES

Chairperson Amanda Russell called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Tuesday, April 29, 2014, at 6:36 p.m. in Room 305 of the McConnell Center.

Those members present were Amanda Russell, Betsey Andrews Parker, Kathleen Morrison, Sarah Greenshields, Doris Grady, Carole Soule McCammon, and Michelle Muffett-Lipinski. Also in attendance were Robin LaFleur and Kim Haas, Fosters.

Ms. Russell discussed the process for the evening and reminded Board members about the types of questions that could be asked legally. She stated that the process would be that each Board member would ask a question and continue around the table until the time limit of two hours had been reached.

Mrs. Grady asked if questions derived from the candidate's application could be asked, to which Ms. Andrews Parker responded in the affirmative.

Questions based on a Google search could not be asked. At the end of the interview, the School Board would determine if the candidate would move on to the next phase of the process.

Betsey Andrews Parker moved, Michelle Muffett-Lipinski seconded, to enter nonpublic session at 6:55 p.m. to discuss matters that fall under RSA 91-A:3, II (b) The hiring of any person as a public employee, and (j) consideration of confidential, commercial, or financial information that is exempt from public disclosure under RSA 91-A:5, IV in an adjudicative proceeding pursuant to RSA 541 or 541-A. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 7/0. (All in favor)**

The Board entered into non-public session.

Kathy Morrison moved, Carole Soule McCammon seconded, to adjourn the nonpublic and re-enter the public session at 9:37 p.m. An oral **VOTE PASSED 7/0**. The Board re-entered into public session.

Ms. Andrews Parker stated that she would contact Bob Lister to inform him of the decision to move the candidate for the position of Superintendent forward in the interview/hiring process. She added that there would be a site visit during the week of May 5 and the candidate's name would be released after the candidate was informed.

Michelle Muffett-Lipinski moved, Sarah Greenshields, seconded to adjourn the public session at 9:40 p.m. An oral **VOTE PASSED 7/0**.
