He advised that 60% of the construction documents were complete at this time and that 75% of the construction documents will be completed the first week of November. One hundred percent completion of the documents is expected the 3rd week of November when LaValle Brensinger will be ready to present it to the committee. Harvey Construction will then have a price quote available the 2nd week of December.

Bill Breault gave a brief overview and update on the Orchard Street road construction and overall site work indicating that the relocation of the electrical and water are going smoothly and the project completion is still on schedule with the parking garage being completed in November of 2015 and the police department in February of 2016.

NEW BUSINESS

Bill Breault advised the Committee that he had met with the Mason's who would like to make a presentation to the committee members and the public as to the history of the Mason's laying the first piece of corner stone in a new facility.
