OLD BUSINESS

Andrew Martino of Harvey Construction gave an update on the Orchard Street police facility and parking garage design schedule. He advised members that construction documents were issued approximately one week prior to Thanksgiving and went out for bids that are due back on December 19th. He advised that they are hoping for at least three bidders and will take a week or so to go through the bids and compile a guaranteed maximum price. He also advised that with the idea that the bulk excavation is completed by February 1, 2015, drive piling for the police station will start at that time.

Bill Breault provided a recent update on the project schedule to the committee members.

Bob Carrier inquired about the ongoing marketing program being used to keep people informed on the current construction and parking in Dover. He informed the members that the information seems to be very limited at this point and he would like to see that increased as the project gets well underway. It was recommended that Dan Barufaldi attend a future meeting to give the members an update on the marketing program.

Bob Carrier recommended that City Council members and the public be invited to a future meeting to observe recent drawings of the police facility and parking garage and updates could be given. All members present were in favor.
