DOVER SCHOOL BOARD – MINUTES

Chairperson Amanda Russell called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Monday, April 6, 2015, at 6:00 p.m. in the Superintendent's Conference Room in the McConnell Center.

Michelle Muffett-Lipinski moved, Sarah Greenshields seconded, to enter nonpublic session at 6:01 p.m. to discuss matters that fall under RSA 91-A:3, II (A) THE DISMISSAL, PROMOTION, OR COMPENSATION OF ANY PUBLIC EMPLOYEE OR THE DISCIPLINING OF SUCH EMPLOYEE, OR THE INVESTIGATION OF ANY CHARGES AGAINST HIM OR HER, UNLESS THE EMPLOYEE AFFECTED (1) HAS A RIGHT TO A MEETING AND (2) REQUESTS THAT THE MEETING BE OPEN, IN WHICH CASE THE REQUEST SHALL BE GRANTED AND RSA91-a:3, II (J) CONSIDERATION OF CONFIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL, OR FINANCIAL INFORMATION THAT IS EXEMPT FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE UNDER RSA 91-A:5, IV IN AN ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING PURSUANT TO RSA 541. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 7/0. (All in favor)**

The Board entered into non-public session.

Michelle Muffett-Lipinski moved, Carole Soule McCammon seconded, to adjourn the nonpublic and re-enter the public session at 7:35 p.m. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 7/0**. The Board re-entered into public session.
