Chairperson Amanda Russell called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Monday, July 20, 2015, at 6:05 p.m. in room 305 of the McConnell Center.

Those members present were Amanda Russell, Doris Grady, Sarah Greenshields and Carole Soule McCammon. Betsey Andrews Parker arrived at 6:13. Ann Chapman and Robin LaFleur were also present. Michelle Muffett-Lipinski and Kathy Morrison were excused.

Sarah Greenshields moved, Carole Soule McCammon seconded, to enter nonpublic session at 6:06 p.m. to discuss matters that fall under RSA 91-A:3, II (C) MATTERS WHICH, IF DISCUSSED IN PUBLIC WOULD LIKELY ADVERSELY AFFECT THE REPUTATION OF ANY PERSON, OTHER THAN A MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC BODY ITSELF, UNLESS SUCH PERSON REQUESTS AN OPEN MEETING. THIS EXEMPTION SHALL EXTEND TO ANY APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE OR TAX ABATEMENT OF WAIVER OF A FEE, FINE, OR OTHER LEVY, IF BASED ON INABILITY TO PAY OR POVERTY OF THE APPLICANT. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 4/0. (All in favor)**

The Board entered into non-public session.

Carole Soule McCammon, Sarah Greenshields seconded, to adjourn the nonpublic and re-enter the public session at 7:04 p.m. An oral **VOTE PASSED 5/0**. The Board re-entered into public session.

Betsey Andrews Parker moved, Carole Soule McCammon seconded to seal the minutes of the nonpublic session as divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of a person other than a member of the body and divulgence would render the proposed action ineffective. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 5/0**.
