

DHS-CTC JBC Update for City Council and School Board

- The City Council formally voted to authorize the funds required for the construction of a new Dover High School/Career and Technical Center at a recent City Council meeting. The total project costs are estimated at \$86.5 million, with \$13.5 million coming from the State of NH. The JBC will now move into the next design phases in order to develop more detailed plans and construction documents. School and community groups will be invited to meet with the JBC to discuss specific aspects of the design, including the types of learning, performance and athletic spaces needed.
- The JBC approved HMFH as the architects who will complete the DHS/CTC project with us. HMFH has been working on the feasibility study, and we are pleased to have them continuing with us. The JBC scrutinized the contract and fee proposal to ensure that it meets the needs of Dover and of this project, and the proposal was approved at the last JBC meeting.
