DOVER SCHOOL BOARD – MINUTES

Chairperson Amanda Russell called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Tuesday, October 13, 2015, at 7:35 p.m. in Room 305 of the McConnell Center.

Those members present were Amanda Russell, Betsey Andrews Parker, Sarah Greenshields Carole Soule McCammon and Kathy Morrison. Doris Grady and Michelle Muffett-Lipinski were excused. Also in attendance were Elaine Arbour, Peter Driscoll and Robin LaFleur.

Betsey Andrews Parker moved, Carole Soule McCammon seconded, to enter nonpublic session at 7:37 p.m. to discuss matters that fall under RSA 91-A:3, II (C) MATTERS WHICH, IF DISCUSSED IN PUBLIC WOULD LIKELY ADVERSELY AFFECT THE REPUTATION OF ANY PERSON, OTHER THAN A MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC BODY ITSELF, UNLESS SUCH PERSON REQUESTS AN OPEN MEETING. THIS EXEMPTION SHALL EXTEND TO ANY APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE OR TAX ABATEMENT OF WAIVER OF A FEE, FINE, OR OTHER LEVY, IF BASED ON INABILITY TO PAY OR POVERTY OF THE APPLICANT. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 5/0. (All in favor)**

The Board entered into non-public session.

Carole Soule McCammon moved, Sarah Greenshields seconded, to adjourn the nonpublic and re-enter the public session at 8:30 p.m. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 4/0**. The Board re-entered into public session. While in non-public session, Betsey Andrews Parker recused herself from discussion and left the meeting at 7:52 p.m.

Carole Soule McCammon moved, Sarah Greenshields seconded to seal the minutes of the nonpublic session as divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of a person other than a member of the body and divulgence would render the proposed action ineffective. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 4/0**.

Sarah Greenshields moved, Carole Soule McCammon seconded to adjourn the public session at 8:32 p.m. An oral **VOTE PASSED 4/0**.
