Vice Chairperson Betsey Andrews Parker called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Monday, October 5, 2015, at 6:00 p.m. in the Superintendent's Conference room in the McConnell Center.

Those members present were Doris Grady, Sarah Greenshields, Betsey Andrews Parker, Michelle Muffett-Lipinski and Kathy Morrison. Carole Soule McCammon was excused and Amanda Russell recused herself from the meeting. Also in attendance were Elaine Arbour, Peter Driscoll and Robin LaFleur. Michelle Muffett-Lipinski recused herself and left the meeting at 6:01 p.m.

Sarah Greenshields moved, Doris Grady seconded, to enter nonpublic session at 6:02 p.m. to discuss matters that fall under RSA 91-A:3, II (C) MATTERS WHICH, IF DISCUSSED IN PUBLIC WOULD LIKELY ADVERSELY AFFECT THE REPUTATION OF ANY PERSON, OTHER THAN A MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC BODY ITSELF, UNLESS SUCH PERSON REQUESTS AN OPEN MEETING. THIS EXEMPTION SHALL EXTEND TO ANY APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE OR TAX ABATEMENT OF WAIVER OF A FEE, FINE, OR OTHER LEVY, IF BASED ON INABILITY TO PAY OR POVERTY OF THE APPLICANT. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 4/0. (All in favor)**

The Board entered into non-public session.

Sarah Greenshields moved, Doris Grady seconded, to adjourn the nonpublic and re-enter the public session at 7:03 p.m. An oral **VOTE PASSED 4/0**. The Board re-entered into public session.
