NOTES

A motion was made by Otis Perry to approve the September 10, 2015 Police Facility Building Committee minutes and it was seconded by Tony Colarusso. All members present were in favor.

CITIZEN'S FORUM

No one addressed the Police & Parking Facility Building Committee Citizen's Forum at the November 12, 2015 meeting.

OLD BUSINESS

Bill Breault gave an update to the committee members on the Arts Commission assisting with the interior color/way-finding of the garage facility. He presented the members with five color samples that the Arts Commission submitted and requested that the members review them and accept a proposal for the Arts Commission to go forward with the selected colors. Otis Perry advised that the Parking Commission should also review the proposed color scheme and he made a motion to accept the proposed colors pending approval by the Parking Commission. Sergeant Collopy seconded the motion and all members present were in favor.

Dale Doller presented an updated sample board representing the colors that were picked out for the police facility interior finishes.

Andrew Martino gave a brief update on the project schedule. He advised that the parking garage will open as planned at the end of the month and that the police facility will be completed by the end of February. Andrew Martino reported that finishes to the outside surrounding areas will be taking place in the next couple weeks so that when the winter weather hits, all work will be focused on the inside of the police facility.

Bill Breault discussed the opening ceremony for the new parking facility. After a brief discussion, it was decided that an opening ceremony would take place following the week of the Dover Annual Christmas Parade.

Andrew Martino advised that as of this date the project budget is right on track.
