Teaching Positions

1. World Language- Part-time Spanish

*Enrollments

#13/14- 381

#14/15- 412

#15/16- 423

*high enrollments in Spanish I and II classes

*numbers have to be considered over four year cycles

2. Art

*enrollments

#13/14- 740 (26 Independent Studies)

#14/15- 676 (23 Independent Studies)

#15/16- 615 (19 Independent Studies, does not reflect Second Semester)

*during 13/14 all Art teachers taught six sections and during 14/15 some Art teachers taught six, they now teach five; Independent Studies generally equal a section

*students are signing up for Art classes but we cannot run the sections, these students are directed to other electives or study halls

3. Wellness

*currently have two/three teaching stations based on usage of gymnasium and weight room; outside facilities used when weather permits

*will have three/four teaching stations in new building stations based on usage of gymnasium and weight room; outside facilities used when weather permits

*Physical Education Credit for Sports Participation- Students in grades 10-12 may earn ½ Physical Education credit for successful completion of no less than two seasons of an interscholastic sport between their sophomore year and first semester of their senior year. Credit will be given ONLY to those students who qualify for an end of the year award: letter, numeral, star, or certificate of participation.

Stipends

1. Robotics- Class II- growing program of 50 students that includes mentoring of a new Middle School Program
2. Search- Class II- “Gifted and Talented” Program facilitated by the University of New Hampshire- number is limited to eight because of program costs; students pay a fee to participate and our registration cost and transportation is primarily funded through the hosting of a Ropes Course Day for participating schools

Library Aide

1. Library is currently opened before school at 6:45 am by a faculty volunteer. It is closed after school unless the librarian is available.
2. One block a day the library is closed to students from study halls because of a lack of supervision. Teachers can still bring their classrooms at that time. Coverage is provided during lunch by a teacher as part of the duty schedule.
