DOVER SCHOOL BOARD – MINUTES

Chairperson Amanda Russell called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Monday, October 31, 2016, at 6:05 p.m. in Superintendent Conference Room at the McConnell Center.

Those members present were Amanda Russell, Keith Holt, Matthew Lahr, Betsey Andrews Parker, Carolyn Mebert and Michelle Muffett-Lipinski. Kathy Morrison was excused.

Betsey Andrews Parker moved, Michelle Muffett-Lipinski seconded, to enter nonpublic session at 6:06 p.m. to discuss matters that fall under RSA 91-A:3 II(c), Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the public body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine, or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant. This nonpublic meeting is additionally not open to the public per RSA 91-A:3 II (j), Consideration of confidential, commercial or financial information that is exempt from public disclosure under RSA 91-A:5, IV in an adjudicative proceeding pursuant to RSA 541 or RSA 541. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 6/0. (All in favor)**

The Board entered non-public session to discuss a personnel matter.

Michelle Muffett-Lipinski moved, Carolyn Mebert seconded, to adjourn the nonpublic and re-enter the public session at 6:58 p.m. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 6/0 (all in favor)**. The Board re-entered into public session.

Betsey Andrews Parker moved, Michelle Muffett-Lipinski seconded to seal the minutes of the nonpublic session as divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of a person other than a member of the body and divulgence would render the proposed action ineffective. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 6/0 (all in favor)**.

Michelle Muffett-Lipinski moved, Carolyn Mebert seconded to adjourn the public session at 7:07 p.m. An oral **VOTE PASSED 6/0**.
