DOVER SCHOOL BOARD – MINUTES

Chairperson Amanda Russell called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Monday, October 3, 2016, at 5:47 p.m. in Superintendent Conference Room at the McConnell Center.

Those members present were Superintendent Elaine Arbour, Amanda Russell, Keith Holt, Matthew Lahr, Betsey Andrews Parker, and Kathy Morrison. Carolyn Mebert arrived at 5:51 p.m. Michelle Muffett-Lipinski was excused. Attorney Melissa Hewey was also present.

Matt Lahr moved, Betsey Andrews Parker seconded, to enter nonpublic session at 5:48 p.m. to discuss matters that fall under RSA 91-A:3, II c, matters which, if discussed, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the public body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine, or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant and (j), Consideration of confidential, commercial or financial information that is exempt from public disclosure under RSA 91-A:5, IV in an adjudicative proceeding pursuant to RSA 541 or RSA 541-A. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 5/0. (All in favor)**

The Board entered into non-public session to discuss a personnel matter and Nottingham contract negotiations.

Keith Holt moved, Matt Lahr seconded, to adjourn the nonpublic and re-enter the public session at 6:53 p.m. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 6/0 (all in favor)**. The Board re-entered into public session.

Betsey Andrews Parker moved, Matt Lahr seconded to seal the minutes of the nonpublic session as divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of a person other than a member of the body and divulgence would render the proposed action ineffective. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 6/0 (all in favor)**.

Matt Lahr moved, Keith Holt seconded to adjourn the public session at 6:55 p.m. An oral **VOTE PASSED 6/0**.
