DOVER SCHOOL BOARD – MINUTES

Chairperson Amanda Russell called a meeting of the Dover School Board to order on Monday, November 14, 2016, at 6:30 p.m. in Superintendent Conference Room at the McConnell Center.

Those members present were Amanda Russell, Keith Holt, Matthew Lahr, Betsey Andrews Parker, Kathy Morrison, Carolyn Mebert and Michelle Muffett-Lipinski. Also present was Superintendent Elaine Arbour.

Michelle Muffett-Lipinski moved, Matt Lahr seconded, to enter nonpublic session at 6:31 p.m. to discuss matters that fall under RSA 91-A:3 II(a), The dismissal, promotion, or compensation of any public employee or the disciplining of such employee, or the investigation of any charges against him or her, unless the employee affected (1) has a right to a meeting and (2) requests that the meeting be open, in which case the request shall be granted. This nonpublic meeting is additionally not open to the public per RSA 91-A:3 II (c), Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the public body itself, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement of waiver of a fee, fine, or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant. This nonpublic meeting is additionally not open to the public per RSA 91-A:3 II A roll call **VOTE PASSED 7/0. (All in favor)**

The Board entered non-public session to discuss a personnel matter.

The Board discussed whether the minutes of the nonpublic session would be sealed and all in attendance determined that they would not be sealed.

Michelle Muffett-Lipinski moved, Matt Lahr seconded, to adjourn the nonpublic and re-enter the public session at 7:04 p.m. A roll call **VOTE PASSED 7/0 (all in favor)**. The Board re-entered into public session.
