**3. Minutes of November 9, 2016**

Woodburn motioned to approve the minutes of 11/9/16, Bannon seconded. VOTE: Unanimous.

**4. Results of Park Programming Survey**

Martel: Let's go through the survey list starting from the top and talk about if that use is appropriate for this park or is better suited to another park.

Purcell: We should talk to Molly at the Chamber of Commerce about some of the items that scored high since they are involved.

Farmer's Market and food trucks: could be in Henry Law Park or could be accommodated in the current park design, without significant changes.

Picnic Tables: Yes in areas where people congregate, some permanent and some temporary. Benches in lawn area and more urban areas.

Performance Space: near plaza or lawn area. Informal, not in place of the Rotary Arts.

Need shade in the plaza and lighting and security cameras.

Movie night: use inflatable screen, no dedicated space set aside. Check with Main Street.

Fun seating: Yes as part of public art.

Ice skating: only with a mobile system, not permanent.

Yes to public art, paddle craft sports and ramp, and historic markers with Main Street.

No to water feature since it will be in Henry Law Park.

Yes for Community Boat House, depending on private funding.

Rock climbing idea was discussed. Depends on the type of rock and proximity to homes above and below.

Nature markers and way finding can be added in the future.

Outdoor classroom can be accommodated.

No to dog park, put in Maglaras Park.

Fitness Stations: Only in the walking trail loop in the future.

Cycling facilities: only bike racks.

No boat storage, wedding pavilion, parkour or cyclocross. Wedding tents can be added as needed.

No need for future meeting at this point.

Martel to update CWDAC on Tuesday.
