Councilor Ciotti moved to recommend the reappointment of Lee Skinner to the Planning Board; seconded by Mayor Weston.

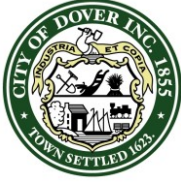
