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The City Council will meet in a Public Meeting to enter a Non-public Session to discuss the following topic:

Personnel hiring, compensation, and evaluation.

NOTE: The non-public meeting is not open to the public per RSA 91-A:3 II(a), The dismissal, promotion, or compensation of any public employee or the disciplining of such employee, or the investigation of any charges against him or her, unless the employee affected (1) has a right to a meeting and (2) requests that the meeting be open, in which case the request shall be granted; and per RSA 91-A:3 II(b), the hiring of any person as a public employee.

Councilors Present: Mayor Weston, Deputy Mayor Carrier and Councilors Thibodeaux, Gagnon, Shanahan, O'Connor, Greenshields, Ciotti and Gasses.

Others Present: City Manager Mike Joyal and City Attorney Anthony Blenkinsop.

Public Meeting to enter non-public commenced at 6:05pm.

Motion to enter non-public meeting for purposes of discussing personnel compensation and hiring per RSA 91-A:3 II(a) and (b) made by Gasses, seconded by Ciotti.
Roll call vote unanimous.

Upon entering the non-public meeting, the Mayor and Councilors were briefed by the City Manager concerning the hiring and proposed compensation of the new Community Services Director. Discussion then ensued relating to the performance evaluation of the City Manager. Information presented included a review of expected outcomes as previously established for the City Manager (see attached).

Motion to recess the non-public session until later in the evening following completion of Regular Meeting made by Councilor Gagnon, seconded by Gasses. Voice vote unanimous.

Non-public meeting recessed at 6:55pm.

Non-public meeting reconvened at 10:10pm following completion of the Regular Meeting with all previously attending present.

Discussion continued regarding the performance evaluation of the City Manager and recognition of his performance by addressing amendments proposed to be made to his employment agreement. Due to the late hour, Councilors agreed to recess meeting until 7/12/2017 to allow more time for additional discussion and feedback to occur.

Motion to recess the non-public session to 7/12/2017 made by Councilor Gagnon, seconded by Greenshields. Voice vote unanimous.
