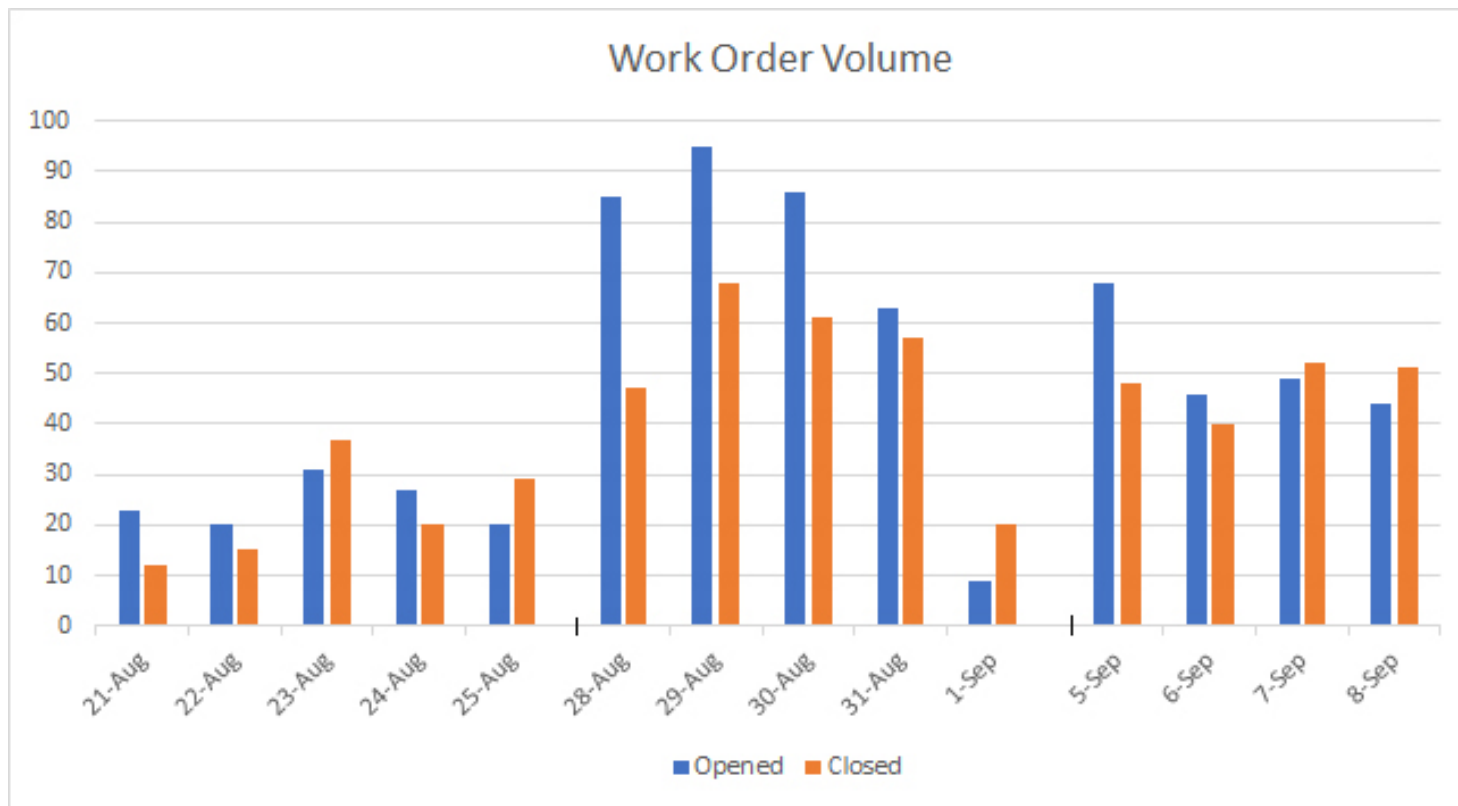
- IT Support

2. Classroom Technology

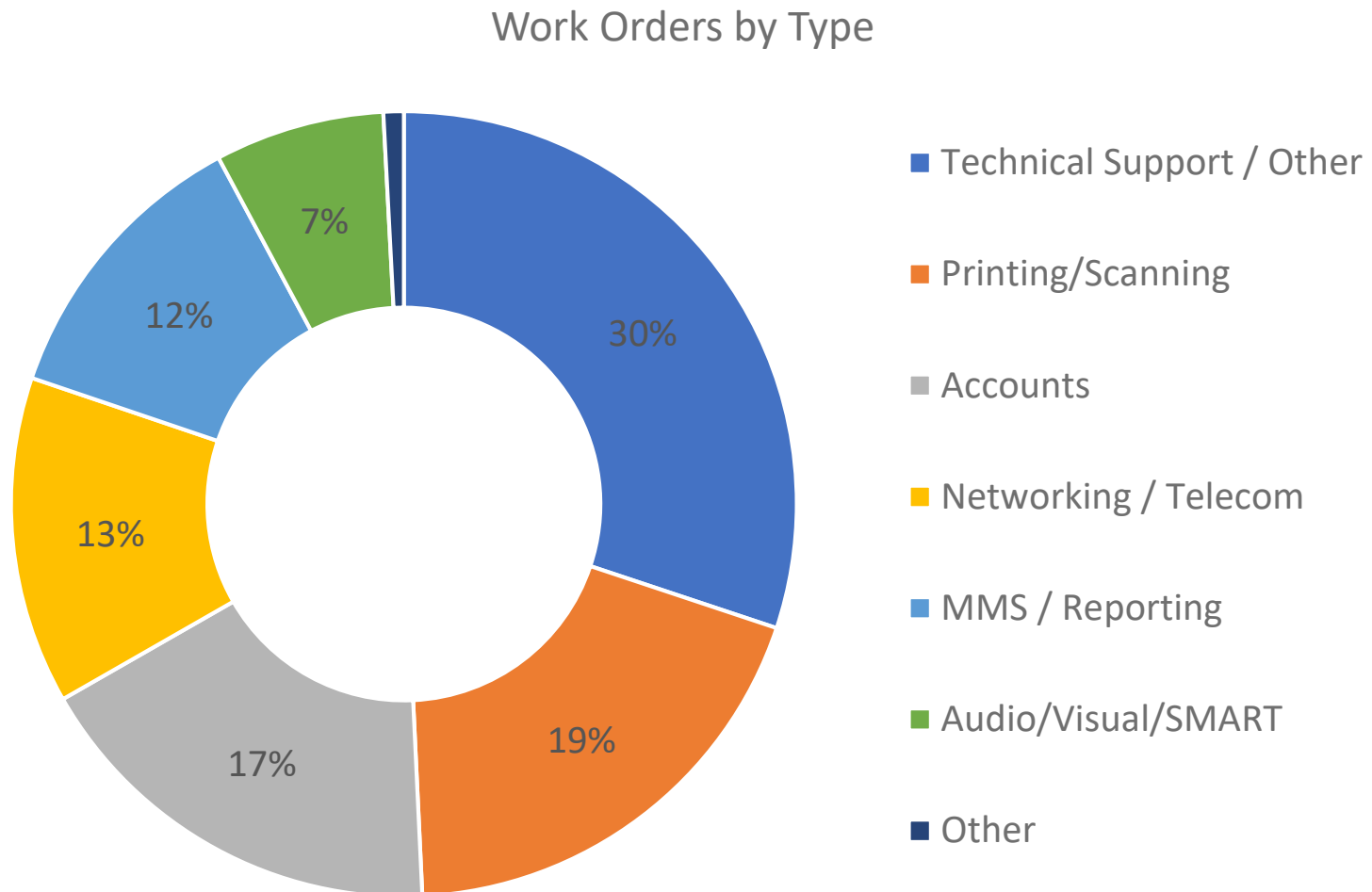
- Student Computer Labs (local funds - 1 per year)
 - DMS Computer Classroom – 30 devices
- Student Computer Carts (donated)
 - DMS PTO – 25 devices (+5 & cart)
 - STEAM – 14 devices (+ cart)
 - Microsoft / Connection – 18 devices & cart

3. School Year Start – IT Support

- Since August 21st
 - 699 tickets opened | 547 tickets closed (78.3%)

4. New Equipment Deployments

- **100 Classroom Teacher Packages**
 - Touch screen convertible tablet w/pen
 - 24" monitor
 - Keyboard/mouse/docking station
- **10 Staff Computers**
 - 10 new staff desktops (5 year rotation through ~50)
- **30 Projectors @ DHS**
 - 10 projectors purchased at the end of FY17
 - 10 projectors being purchased later this month
 - Up to 20 more projectors being purchased late FY18
