MEETING MINUTES

A) Review and Approval of October meeting minutes

STAFF UPDATES

A) Downtown Development – Christopher Parker, Assistant City Manager

Assistant City Manager Christopher Parker updated the Commission on various downtown development projects including 104 Washington St., Third Street, and Mechanic and Chapel streets. He also reported that due to delays in the development of the Third St. parking lot property, the lot would be reopened for the holiday season.

B) Parking Activity & Budget – William Simons, Parking Manager

Parking Manager William Simons presented meter activity and financial numbers for October. He reported that income was 9 percent ahead of projected levels. Additionally the highlighted that the average number of parking meter transactions per days has increased by 7.5 percent.



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OLD BUSINESS

A) Electric Charging Stations

Parking Manager William Simons updated the Commission on information from Tesla Inc., regarding the installation of electric vehicle charging stations in the garage. The Parking Manager said he will finalize information with Tesla as to how much the company would put toward the installation of both charging stations exclusively for Tesla vehicles and universal stations for other electric vehicles.
