Please accept this letter as notice of my resignation from my position as K-8 Mathematics Facilitator. I plan to finish out my contract for the 2017-18 school year.

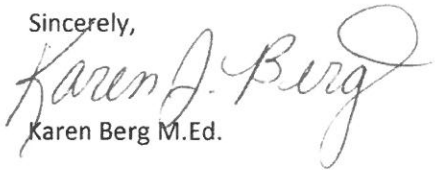
I received an offer to become the Curriculum Coordinator in the Barrington School District. I am excited to grow as an educational leader and look forward to new experiences in this position.
