What is YLI?

The YOUTH LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE (YLI) is a convening of youth leaders, youth organizers, adult allies, and educators from across New England whose shared vision of education equity is grounded in a model that places students at the center of their own learning. With the generous support of the Nellie Mae Education Foundation, YLI attendees come together annually to build understanding and support for youth organizing for education justice, develop relationships, share learning, and plan for youth organizing work in the upcoming school year.

Who can come to YLI?

Attendance at YLI is by invitation only. Invited organizations can bring up to six (6) young people, and they *must* be accompanied by two (2) adult allies who can be at YLI all three days.
